


LOGO



HEADERS



Blog posts use a header like this one (made with <u>Canva</u>) as a featured image. The left side names the post type over an eggplant or razzmatazz background with white text. The right side is an image relevant to the post.

POSTANNOUNCEMENTS



Blog post announcements for my social media accounts look like this example from Threads. It consists of the following parts:

- Two alert emojis () on either side of the words "New Blog Post" or just "Blog Post" for reposts.
- A short description of the post, ending with the word "Enjoy!" and a wink emoji ().
- A link to the post.
- The post's featured image (not the link preview!).

LinkedIn has the same format but without the emoji.

"Me.jpg" is the default image for my personal social media accounts (Threads, Bluesky, IG, LinkedIn, etc.), while "Site logo.png" is for my professional accounts (FB & Mastodon). A larger version of "Site logo.png," called "Cover.png," is my default header/banner.
